I am requesting funding for the project titled "Temple, TX Henderson Parkway and Trail" in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Temple, TX at 2 N Main St Temple TX 76501.

The funding would be used to construct a new two-lane street with parallel parking, a 9-foot-wide bicycle lane, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk, and a 12-foot-wide shared-use path, with a landscaped buffer on both sides. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve mobility as well as enhance crime prevention, by eliminating the dead-ends and discouraging crimes from being committed in full view of the public street, in this rapidly growing Central Texas city.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 23 USC 133.
