Student Release Forms must be filled out and submitted with a high resolution .jpg of the Artwork – please send .jpg saved as a file with **FirstName LastName_School**

How to take a picture of artwork:

Make sure flash is off on camera/phone camera

Photograph artwork in natural/indirect light and turn off Live photo mode

Do not photograph framed artwork as reflection of glass will distort the photographed submission

All photographs should be high resolution .jpg format - .jpg must be titled with **Student's FirstName LastName_School**

Files should not exceed 2MB

For 2 Dimensional Collages, please send a front, side & rear view .jpg with the Artwork against a plain background. Turn off Live photo mode

Emails must be submitted by Teacher when possible, apart from Home School Programs.

Due date for ALL online submissions is **Wednesday April 21st by 5pm**

Overall Winner's Artwork will need to be framed according to Art Competition Rules & Guidelines and is at the Winner's expense.

Facebook Fan Favorite contest & all artwork will be hosted on Congressman Carter's Social Media
